### Tutorial 1 • Getting Started

#### First Page

1. Open the file “greywolf\_START.html” in Dreamweaver and Save As “greywolf.html.”
2. Insert and centre Header image: images/\_DSC0067\_1004.jpg
3. Link to Home (index.html) and The Grey Wolf (greywolf.html)
4. Make “The Grey Wolf” into a heading <h1...h6>, where h1 is the biggest.
5. Designate each paragraph with a <p> tag (opening and closing tags).
6. Insert image “\_DSC0061.jpg” in front of paragraph, float left with 20px margin.
7. Indent the text block left and right.
8. Choose and measure light RGB colours from the image, and colour the header and body.

#### Dreamweaver Site and Upload

1. Make the Tutorial 1 folder into a new Dreamweaver Site, connect to the Ryerson Student Web Server (STW), and upload “greywolf.html” and the Images folder to your site.
2. Set file permissions using FileZilla (Figure 2).
3. Verify that your site works and that your page is visible on the Internet.
4. Please note that only CCS can set up your account on the Student Web Server. CCS Help: x 6840, email help@ryerson.ca.
